For those members on temporary lay-off, you need to check your paystubs from Service Canada to find out whether you are receiving CERB or EI. When your claim switches to EI, forward a screenshot with that information to payroll.inquiries@saskpolytech.ca then the top up can be processed.

Hours of work

With a majority of our members working from home, this is a reminder that the core hours of regulated thirty-six (36) hour employees are:

- Monday through Friday from 8:30 am to 4:00 pm
- Employees shall not start earlier than 7:30 am and finish work no later than 5:00 pm
