Your bargaining team has met to exchange non-monetary as well as housekeeping proposals in early October. More bargaining dates have been set for November for further discussion and negotiations.

Extended Health Benefits

Costing of enhancements to the existing benefit plan have been requested, however has not been received as of this communication. The PSBU plan has been running a deficit in recent years. As such your bargaining committee will be cognizant of the implications of enhancements, deficit charges to the surplus as well as the long-term financial effects that the pandemic will have on the existing plan. Updates will be shared as they become available.

PSBU Member Increase

The PSBU membership is at an all-time high with a FTE (full time equivalent) of 568 as of the end of August and that number continues to climb.

Grievance Numbers

The number of grievances are on the decline as we continue to work on are finding resolve to many of our issues.
