Dr. Rosia has sent out an email indicating that Sask Polytech has been named by Mediacorp as one of Canada's top 100 employers. Your bargaining committee are proud to point out that many of the eligibility qualifications are bargained rights, including:

- maternity top-up payments for new mothers (to 100% of salary for 17 weeks), as well as parental leave top-up payments that extend to new dads and adoptive parents (to 100% of salary for 17 weeks) Article 10.18
- defined contribution pension plan Article 18.4
- employees start with 3 weeks and earn up to 7 weeks of paid vacation Article 12
- employees may also apply for self-funded and unpaid leaves of absence (for up to 1 year in duration) Article 16
